

VAL, DMF COVID Hosp inaugurated

A 110 bed Covid Care Hospital has inaugurated here today in the presence of Health Minister Naba Das, MP Suresh Pujari, CEO, VAL, C N Singh, Chairman Hi-tech Medical College, Tirupati Panigrahi and others.

Minister Das said the facility has 97 isolation beds and 10 ICUs. District administration has signed MOU with Hi-tech Medical authority for the management of the Hospital. Twelve doctors, 90 paramedics will man the hospital.

Vedanta Ltd., Jharuguda is providing required medical

gear like masks, goggles, surgical gowns and caps, specialized medical equipment like nebulizers, ventilators, oxygen concentrators, etc. Mr. CN Singh, CEO-Vedanta Ltd., Jharsuguda said, "Vedanta dedicates the District COVID Hospital to the five lakhs people of Jharsuguda.

The company has made over 1000 dry ration kits available to daily wage earners, slum dwellers, marginal communities and needy individuals and households across Jharsuguda, till date, distributed 80,000 masks to villagers, disinfected public utilities and pressed its mobile health unit in the villages, he informed.
